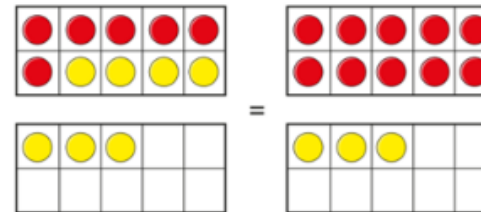
Topic

This week we have been looking at maps and how they are useful in our everyday lives.

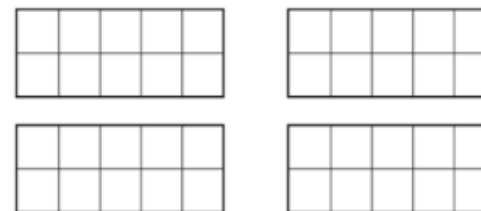
Challenge: Can you create a map of your journey from home to school?
